“Guidelines for Dock Equipment”

In an effort to ensure that our docks are maintained in a safe and professional manner the Yachting Committee has decided to establish Standards for Dock Equipment where possible. This will include and is not limited to Dock Boxes, Hose Holders, Steps, Hoist, Satellite Dish, Cleats, etc.

Dock Boxes: “This will apply to all slips at the WYCC”

One dock box is permitted for each assigned slip. The Dock Box will be purchased/supplied by the lessee / boat owner. This box will be constructed of white fiberglass and its dimensions shall not exceed 22” deep x 24” high x 85” wide. If a member wishes to use a dock box other than the “approved” they will need approval from the Yachting Committee.

The approved location for installation will be in the center of the slip on the main dock and will be placed so as not to obstruct traffic on the dock. All Dock Boxes will be installed by the Dockmaster at no cost to the lessee / boat owner. The lessee / boat owner will be required to pay a material charge for the lumber required for the installation.

Removal and reinstallation of Dock Boxes as a result of a storm will be the responsibility of the lessee / boat owner and is highly recommended to prevent damage to the docks.

Dock Boxes that are in use now on the docks will fall under a grandfather provision and will be allowed to remain on the docks. If a lessee / boat owner wants or needs to replace an existing Dock Box it will need to be replaced with an “approved” Dock Box. If an existing grandfathered Dock Box is removed, except in the event of a storm, it cannot be reinstalled on the dock without the approval of the Yachting Committee.

If a Dock Box that is in use now falls into disrepair and it is deemed by the Yachting Committee to be unsightly or unsafe the lessee / boat owner will be notified that the Dock Box must be removed or replaced. The lessee / boat owner will have 30 days to remove the Dock Box. If it is not removed in the 30 day time period by the lessee / boat owner it will be removed by the Dockmaster and the cost of removal will be charged to the lessee / boat owner’s account.

Hose Holder: “This will apply to the new slips on “A” 1 - 34 and “E” 17 - 22 Docks”

One (1) “Hose Holder” will be supplied and installed at each slip by the WYCC. The lessee / boat owner will be required to supply their own hose. All hoses must be placed on this hose holder when not in use.

Satellite Dish: “This will apply to all slips at the WYCC”

No Satellite Dishes will be permanently installed on any dock at the WYCC. A Satellite Dish can be installed on a temporary basis. Please contact the Dockmaster before making any temporary installation.

Cleats: “This will apply to the new slips on “A” 1 - 34 and “E” 17 - 22 Docks”

Two (2) “Cleats” will be supplied and installed at each slip by the WYCC. These cleats will be installed on the dock side pilings. This is to allow for easier adjustment of the lines by the Dockmaster during storms. Additional cleats for other pilings will be allowed at the expense of the lessee / boat owner. Please contact the Dockmaster before making any additional cleat installation.

CLEATS ARE ONLY PERMITTED ON THE PILINGS.

NO CLEATS ARE TO BE INSTALLED ON THE DOCK SURFACE.

Electric Box: “This will apply to the new slips on “A” 1 - 34 and “E” 17 - 22 Docks”

Electric Power will be supplied to each slip. No modifications will be permitted to the electric box by the lessee / boat owner. Please contact the Dockmaster if you have any problems.

NO LINES, HOSES, ETC. ARE TO BE HUNG ON THE ELECTRIC BOX AT ANY TIME.

NO LINES SHALL BE TIED AROUND THE PILING BELOW THE ELECTRIC BOX AT ANY TIME.

Yacht Committee reserves the right to amend the “Guidelines for Dock Equipment” from time to time, as required by either, written notice to the lessee / boat owner or Prominent Publication by notice on the WYCC grounds.
